- 4. Prof. M. A. Kakade and Dr. M. S. Chavan asked reasons about students getting 'XX' grade and they are suggested to take care about numbers of 'XX' grade students.
- 5. Prof. S. S. Mohite and Prof. R. A. Kanai explained the process for getting 'XX' grade and summer term coaching facilities provided to them.
- 6. House congratulated the toppers and successful students.

Item No.3.5:-

To discuss and finalize formula for conversion of grade in to percentage

Member Secretary Prof. V. B. Patil presented the formula, converting CPI to percentage marks for discussion and approval of house.

Percentage Marks = (CPI - 0.75) * 10

Where, CPI means Cumulative Performance Index of student at end of particular year of graduation,

It may converted as follows.

Prof M. A. Kakade and Dr. M. S. Chavan showed the curiosity about difference in class distribution about UG and PG Programme. Prof. V. B. Patil and Dr. N. D. Sangle explained the thought process behind it. Dr. M. M. Awati also gave inputs about the process.

Prof. M. A. Kakade suggested that consider guidelines regarding it from Shivaji University, Kolhapur, UGC and AICTE.

Prof. R. A Kanai explained that, the above guidelines are being considered from SUK UG and PG (Technology Department) rule and regulation, also few guidelines from AICTE handbook 2010-2011.

House agreed unanimously the formula of converting CPI to percentage and class distributions.

Prof. V. B Patil presented the activity completion chart which was appreciated by all members about its accurate implementations.

Prof. M. A. Kakade explained the process adopted in SUK about the disposal of answer book, the time bond of which is after every six months. He mentioned ADCET should follow the standard procedure of disposal and recycle of answer book, as followed in SUK. Timeframe can be decided by ADCET itself.

Dr. M. S. Chavan suggested to keep sample based answer book and dispose the rest.

Dr. M. M. Awati agreed to set procedure and batch sizes of answer book for keeping on sample basis and will be put in the next meeting for approval.

The date can be adjusted accordingly and if not possible MSE for S. Y. B. Tech (All) Lateral Entry can be handover to respective department as a special arrangement.
