Agenda Item No.1: To introduce all BoS members

Mrs A. N. Mulla introduced all members of BoS with their short profiles.

Agenda Item No.2: To discuss and approve first year structure

The chairperson presented the proposed curriculum structure of First year B. Tech. She also presented the complete structure of four years.

Agenda Item No.3: To discuss and approve curriculum contents of branch specific First year courses

The course in-charge presented the curriculum of respective branch specific course.

A. Course: Problem Solving Using C

Mr. L. Ganeshkumar suggested that for Structure and Pointer unit, 10 hours will not be sufficient. He suggested to introduce Compiler and Interpreter concepts, Scripting and Shell programming in the syllabi. Dr. Rashmi Rout mentioned that Array contents are very high and for that 7 hours are again not sufficient. He also suggested to include real time micro homework assignments to students and also to include that in the list of experiments. Chairperson mentioned that this type of practice is being followed in the ISE component. Also, it was clarified that the students will undergo four hours of laboratory sessions per week, so effectively the concepts such as pointers, arrays etc. will be dealt thoroughly during practical sessions.

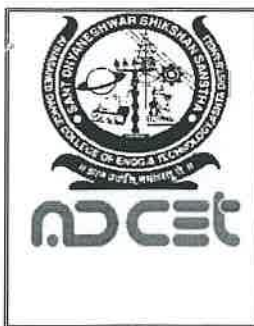
B. Course: Design Thinking

Mr. L. Ganeshkumar mentioned that Design Thinking is part of digital engineering and at first year level students will learn critical and creative thinking. Parameter to be measured should be based on critical and creative thinking, problem solving, communication and collaboration, ethics. He suggested to change the sequence of the units.

C. Course: Data Communications and Networks

Mr. L. Ganeshkumar, Dr. Rashmi Rout and Mr. Vishal Tingre suggested that there should be one unit which should include introduction to all emerging technologies related to the course such as 5G, SDN, Security, Crypto currency etc. Dr. Rashmi Rout suggested that if other





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course is covering security aspects, we can skip those contents here. Mr. L. Ganeshkumar suggested to give more weightage to Transport and Application layer. It was concluded that at least introduction to security can be added at first year and later on 5G, SDN can be included in other networking courses down the line.

D. Course: Object Oriented Programming

Mr. L. Ganeshkumar asked whether Polymorphism is present in the syllabi. Mr. Pradhnyawant said that it is covered in Java course. Mr. Vishal Tingre asked whether debugging techniques are covered in the syllabi. Mr. Pradhnyawant said that it is covered while conducting ISE of the course.

E. Course: Data Communications and Networks Laboratory

The course content was discussed and no specific suggestion was given.

Resolution:-

After undergoing the changes revised First Year B. Tech. CSE (Internet of Things, Cyber Security including Blockchain Technology) Curriculum will be sent to BoS for approval.

Agenda Item No. 4: Any other item with the permission of the chair

Mr. L. Ganeshkumar suggested to give more focus on Communication skills and Soft Skills and if possible to add this in Design Thinking Course. Mr. Vishal suggested to arrange more guest lectures to develop communication skill in students. He also suggested that ethics part should be included in the discussion. He mentioned that communication is important than the language, so try to break the boundary of the language.

Action taken on suggestions received in BoS Meeting held on 20/11/2021 Department of Computer Science and Engineering

Sr. No.	Suggestions	Action Taken
1.	Course: Problem Solving Using C – Mr. L. Ganesh kumar suggested that for Structure and Pointer unit, 10 hours will not be sufficient. He suggested to introduce Compiler and Interpreter concepts, Scripting and Shell programming in the syllabus. Dr. Rashmi Rout mentioned that Array contents are very high and for that 7 hours are again not sufficient. He also suggested to include real time micro homework assignments to students and also to include that in the list of experiments. Chairperson mentioned that this type of practice is being followed in the ISE component. Also, it was clarified that the students will undergo four hours of laboratory sessions per week, so effectively the concepts such as pointers, arrays etc. will be dealt thoroughly during practical sessions.	As per the suggestions, the concepts of structure and pointer are sufficiently covered in Laboratory course: "Problem solving using C". Problem statements on pointers and arrays are included in list of experiments where concepts are clarified thoroughly during practical sessions. Micro project based on some real world problem is conducted in ISE component. In first Unit, C Program development environment is included to address the concepts of compiler, interpreter, etc. Scripting and Shell programming concepts are taken later in Operating system course.
2.	Course: Design Thinking – Mr. L. Ganesh kumar mentioned that Design Thinking is part of digital engineering and at first year level students will learn critical and creative thinking. Parameter to be measured should be based on critical and creative thinking, problem solving, communication and collaboration, ethics. He suggested to change the sequence of the units.	As per the suggestion, in the course "Design Thinking. Laboratory" the sequence of the units have been changed.
3.	Course: Data Communications and Networks – Mr. L. Ganeshkumar, Dr. Rashmi Rout and Mr. Vishal Tingre suggested that there should be one unit which should include introduction to all emerging technologies related to the course such as 5G, SDN, Security, Crypto currency etc.	Title of the course is changed as "Computer Networks". Network security concepts are included in Unit 1. Unit 6 covers concepts such as functionalities, protocols, applications etc. of Transport layer and Application layer. Also protocols in these layers are

As per the requirements, Polymorphism concepts are present in syllabus of "Object Oriented Programming" in unit 4.
5.	Mr. L. Ganeshkumar suggested to give more focus on Communication skills and Soft Skills and if possible, to add this in Design Thinking Course. Mr. Vishal suggested to arrange more guest lectures to develop communication skill in students. He also suggested that ethics part <i>should be included in the discussion</i> . He mentioned that communication is important than the language, so try to break the boundary of the language.	As per the suggestion, in order to improve the communication skills, a separate slot by name "English Club Activity" for duration of 2 hrs is allotted in First Year curriculum.

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
