



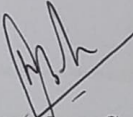

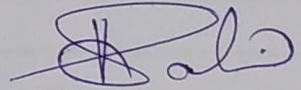

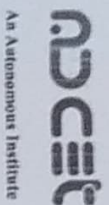
Item No 7	To discuss on the Institutions Admission Statistics of AY 2022 - 2023 through CAP
