Student Medical Aid Policy

1. Purpose & Objective

As sister institutes under the umbrella of Sant Dnyaneshwar Shikshan Sanstha, Student Medical Aid Policy aims to foster an integrated campus ecosystem by ensuring high-quality, immediate, and affordable healthcare. The Student Medical Aid Policy formalizes the healthcare framework through which Hon. Shri. Annasaheb Dange Ayurved Medical College, Post Graduate & Research Center, Ashta. extends its medical, preventive, and emergency facilities to the students, faculty, and staff of Annasaheb Dange College of Engineering and Technology, Ashta .

Recognizing that engineering students face specific risks (mechanical/chemical laboratory accidents) and lifestyles (high academic workload, coding fatigue, and sedentary stress), this policy ensures a safe, healthy environment by integrating acute emergency care with holistic wellness.

2. Scope

This policy applies exclusively to:

- UG and PG. students currently enrolled at the Engineering Institute.
- All teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, and workshop instructors of the Engineering Institute.

3. Dedicated Medical Facilities & Services

Engineering campus members are entitled to the following facilities at the Ayurvedic Medical Hospital:



A. 24/7 Casualty & Workshop Accident Response

- Immediate medical response for workshop-related injuries (cuts, minor burns, electrical shocks, or chemical exposures).
- First-line trauma care, wound dressing, suturing, and stabilization.
- Tetanus toxoid administration and essential allopathic emergency counter-measures.

B. Clinical & Outpatient Departments (OPD)

- **Dressing and First Aid Room:** A dedicated 24/7 unit equipped for wound care, dressing, minor suturing, tetanus injections, and primary stabilization for engineering workshop or laboratory accidents.
- **Kayachikitsa (General Medicine OPD):** Comprehensive treatment for acute and chronic internal medical conditions, seasonal fevers, metabolic issues, and immunity enhancement.
- **Shalya Tantra (Surgeries & Acute Care OPD):** Specialist consultation for surgical conditions, minor injuries, abscesses, and pain management.

C. Therapeutic & Rehabilitative Services

- **Panchakarma Department:** Access to classical detoxification and rejuvenation therapies (e.g., *Abhyanga*, *Potali*, *Shirodhara*). These therapies are specifically integrated to counter academic burnout, insomnia, and computer-vision/coding fatigue.
- **Physiotherapy Unit:** Advanced physical therapy rehabilitation for musculoskeletal conditions, postural correction (essential for students with prolonged computer usage), sports injuries, and repetitive strain injuries.

D. Diagnostic & Imaging Services (Central Laboratory & Radiology)

- **Radiology & X-Ray:** Digital X-ray imaging for rapid detection of bone fractures, joint dislocations, and trauma cases arising from campus activities or sports.
- **Sonography (Ultrasonography / USG):** High-resolution ultrasound scanning for soft-tissue evaluation, abdominal issues, and internal medical assessments.
- **Pathology Laboratory:** Fully automated central lab services for routine and advanced blood, urine, biochemistry, and microbiological testing.



E. Ambulance facility:

100% Free for on-campus transits. Secondary transit to external reference hospitals is provided.

F. Preventive Outreach

- **General Health Checkup Camps:** Bi-annual healthcare screenings conducted on-site at the Engineering Institute to evaluate general vitals, BMI, HB, posture, and systemic health.

4. Financial Tariff & Campus Subsidies

- To ensure affordable healthcare, the following preferential tariff structure applies upon presentation of a valid Engineering Institute ID Card:

Department / Facility	Tariff Policy for Engineering Campus Members
Kayachikitsa & Shalya OPD	100% Free (Consultation and registration fee waived).
Dressing & First Aid	Free for all campus, hostel, and workshop injuries.
Pathology Lab & Radiology (X-Ray/USG)	100% Free
Panchakarma & Physiotherapy	100% Free
General Health Checkup Camps	Completely Free of Cost for all students and staff.

5. Policy Review and Coordination

A Joint Coordination Committee headed by the Secretary, Sant Dnyaneshwar Shikshan Sanstha, and consisting of the Director, Annasaheb Dange College of Engineering and Technology, Ashta and the Director, Hon. Shri. Annasaheb Dange Ayurved Medical College, Post Graduate & Research Center, Ashta shall meet every year to review operations, track utility data, ensure ambulance readiness, and manage the logistics of the General Health Checkup Camps.
