6. Conclusion and feedback

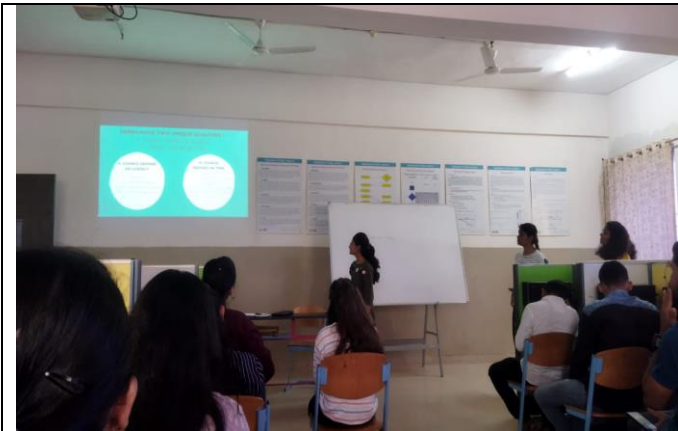
[9] Evaluation/Assessment process followed:
