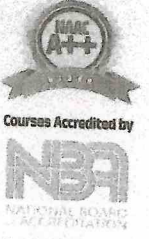

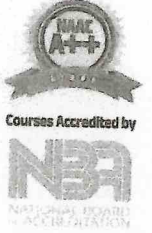

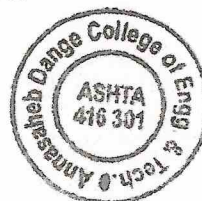

Dear Chief Secretary,

As you may be aware that the exponential rise in the number of internet users in India, in all parts of the country including rural areas, and technological advancements have enabled e-Services and digital payments but also raised cyber threats immensely. Additionally, the use of Artificial intelligence is increasing in everyday life, shaping how we communicate, work, learn, and make decisions. One of the key focus areas is to generate awareness amongst the public at grassroot level about the safe and responsible use of internet & AI and relevance of cyber hygiene.

2. Each year, **Safer Internet Day** is observed globally on the second Tuesday of February to raise awareness about the safe and responsible use of the internet, particularly among children, women, and young people. This year, Safer Internet Day will be celebrated on **10th February 2026** under the theme "**Smart tech, Safe choices – Exploring the safe and responsible use of AI**".
3. To mark the occasion, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) is organizing a nationwide awareness campaign on **10th February 2026**. This initiative, organized under the Information Security Education and Awareness (ISEA) Project, aims to educate diverse internet users on safe online practices, cyber hygiene, major cyber threats, and effective mitigation strategies, while fostering responsible use of internet and AI among citizens.

In this context, like last year, NIC would be conducting Awareness Workshop at the district level through their DIOs/ADIOs on Safer Internet Day, to educate local citizens/officials on internet safety practices and safe & responsible use of AI. In addition, the State Information Officers (SIOs) would be conducting an awareness workshop in the State Headquarters. C-DAC Hyderabad, under the ISEA Project, will extend the necessary support and awareness resources for this campaign.
5. I would be grateful if you could kindly direct respective Departments/Organizations/ District Administration to extend necessary support to the above awareness campaign to make it a huge success.
